















access the electronic database. This may be due to lack of skills in using electronic database or they were unwilling to ask for help from the librarians.

More than half of the respondents 50 (55.6%) stated that the electronic databases collection were related to their field. However, 40 students (44.4%) disagree with the statement. The reason for this is that these 40 students felt that some of the electronic databases available in the library were not related to their field of studies.

Respondents agree with the statement of insufficient computers in the library with more than half of respondents (50 or 55.6%) answered "yes". Although it is convenient to use databases from library but the computers were not enough. As a result some of the respondents were using database from home and office. Nearly 40 (44.4%) respondents mentioned about insufficient computers in this study.

Respondents agree with the statement of lack of assistance from the library when using electronic database with a majority of them (76 or 84.4%) answered "yes". While 14 students (15.6%) answered "No". The reason for lack of assistance from the library may be due to insufficient number of librarians handling electronic database.

Respondents agree with statement of insufficient instructions for using electronic database, majority of students (73 or 81.1%) answered "yes" to not enough instructions, while few of the respondents 17 students (18.9%) answered "No". The library prepared the brochures listing all the databases available but there were no clear instructions given in the brochures or elsewhere for the users to use the databases.

In response to an open-ended question which asks the opinion of the respondents regarding electronic database, most respondents mentioned that language proficiency i.e., English language and the availability of full text articles are the most important factors that the library should consider. With regard to the full text articles suggested by the respondents, the library can provide them to the users and concerning the English language proficiency in searching the database the librarians can assist students in this matter.
